- The channel ensures fast and direct communication with students and staff, especially in emergency or rapidly changing situations.



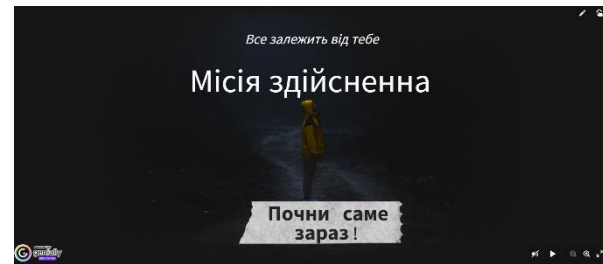
Mystery Breakout

It reflects the institute's use of modern, gamified educational methods to enhance student engagement.



Prognosis and plans for the next two years

1. Expand the list of certified educational programmes.
2. Increase the academic mobility of scientific and teaching staff and students by strengthening cooperation with other higher education institutions, including foreign and research institutions, by concluding cooperation agreements, conducting joint events and projects, organising master classes and inviting guest lecturers to teach at the educational institution.
3. Expand informal education opportunities by organising professional training and involving new stakeholders from among working graduates and employers.
4. Encourage the publication of textbooks and teaching aids by department lecturers, including in foreign languages.
5. Improve conditions for scientific research and development.
6. Intensify work on scientific publications in periodicals included in international scientific metric databases.

Education

ZIEIT follows a clear, relevant mission and development strategy aligned with its educational programmes and national standards. Programmes reflect current industry trends and labor market demands, incorporating feedback from stakeholders and employers.

Emphasis on goal-oriented, student-focused education; includes regular student surveys and feedback monitoring. Strong blend of academic theory and hands-on training in specialized professional environments. Zero tolerance for academic dishonesty; inclusive infrastructure for students with special educational needs.

Quickly transitioned to blended and distance learning via Moodle and modern communication tools.

A certified on-site shelter (with PCs, software, internet, water, toilets, and power supply) serves as a secure learning and testing base.

ZIEIT excels in: economics, business, administration, law, IT, tourism, and foreign languages.

Campus Infrastructure: Includes a lyceum, college, pre-university faculty, and institute.

Facilities: iMac-equipped labs, multimedia labs with satellite tech, electronic library, dormitory, and medical care.

Students

Overhang interested in studies in 2024/2025 was 53%. There is increasing number of students in the last two years (996-1063 students) in long-term educational programmes. Total number of students in last two years: 1290-1520. Current number of students in all educational programs: 1520 students. There are 255 foreign students currently studying at the institution. Integration of 1 student with special educational needs.

Active Student Engagement: Students participate in scientific, practical, and personal development activities to acquire professional and soft skills.

Student Life & Support: Subsidies, scholarships, career loans, insurance, and vibrant student clubs (e.g. English club, Japanese culture, theater, sports).

Pedagogues

Highly qualified teachers (PhDs, Doctors of Science). Qualification of pedagogical staff is 100%.

The institution supports raising of the pedagogues' skills. ZIEIT maintains a systematic approach to faculty professional development. According to institutional policy, all academic staff must complete a qualification upgrade every five years, either through the Faculty of Professional Development or industry-based training. Programs are tailored to align with scientific interests, educational innovation, and strategic institutional goals.

In the past two years, dozens of ZIEIT lecturers and professors have actively participated in national and international training programs, online certifications, internships, conferences, and EU-funded mobility projects. Training has focused on digital literacy, emotional and psychological support, academic integrity,

European integration, education in wartime conditions, legal and economic reforms, and the use of modern teaching methods.

- **International Training & Mobility:** Staff completed internships and Erasmus+ mobilities at institutions such as the University of Bradford (UK), Zagreb University (Croatia), Baltic International Academy (Latvia), and the Catholic University of Poland.
- **Digital Competence & Pedagogical Innovation:** Courses on Google digital tools, interactive teaching, media literacy, and critical thinking were widely completed via platforms like Prometheus, Coursera, and Skillshop.
- **Mental Health & Resilience:** Educators received certified training in psychological first aid, stress management, and emotional support in wartime.
- **Legal & Civic Education:** Participation in training by IFES Ukraine, OSCE, and various international legal conferences enhanced the teaching of law, civic education, and democracy.
- **Scientific Engagement:** Lecturers presented at international conferences (Tokyo, Barcelona, Valencia, Almaty), joined EU research schools, and pursued scientific internships focused on European legal education and economic cybernetics.
- **Specialised Technical Training:** Faculty completed specialized courses in cloud computing, data analysis with Python, network technologies, and combat casualty care.
- **Diverse Topics Covered:** From soft skills development and bullying prevention to sustainable development, gender studies, and IPSO awareness, the programs reflect a well-rounded investment in teacher excellence.

ZIEIT demonstrates a strong institutional commitment to continuous teacher training, educational innovation, and international academic integration—even under challenging conditions such as martial law.

Membership, funds, investments

The institution is a member of these professional association: Association of Educational Institutions of Private Type of Ownership of Ukraine, National Association of Lawyers of Ukraine, Association of Women Lawyers of Ukraine "YurFem", National Association of Advocates of Ukraine (NAAU), Ukrainian Bar Association and Ukrainian Project Management Association.

ZIEIT shows active collaboration with a range of national and international organizations to enhance academic quality, professional training, and student opportunities.

The institution does not receive funding from grant funds.

In the last two years, the ZIEIT investments were distributed as follows:

- Material and technical equipment accounted for 18% of the investments in both 2023/2024 and 2024 (so far).
- Reconstruction activities received 10% of the investments consistently over the two periods.
- Investments in educational process tools increased from 8% in 2023/2024 to 10% in 2024.
- The largest portion of investments was allocated to the educational process related to teachers, representing 64% in 2023/2024 and slightly decreasing to 62% in 2024.

Research

Current research of ZIEIT: Modern Directions of Information Technology Development in Applied Research (Project № 0122U201321).

ZIEIT is actively engaged in applied research aimed at advancing modern IT solutions. The focus emphasizes both educational innovation and scientific investigation, structured to align with institutional strategy and national research priorities.

- Educational Informatization: Development of digital teaching and research tools such as automated databases, electronic resources, and diagnostic software. This supports PhD training, research activities, and the modernization of pedagogical methods
- Integration of Emerging Technologies: Application of advanced IT in areas like AI/machine learning, big data, Internet of Things (IoT), and cybersecurity—especially in smart systems, sustainable infrastructure, and Industry 4.0 environments
- Methodological R&D: Employing design science and system-level approaches to develop robust, scalable architectures for information systems within education and industrial use.

The ZIEIT actively participates in numerous international symposia and conferences across Europe, Asia, and the USA. Faculty members present research on innovative technologies, law, business development, digital transformation, and economic management. Key events include conferences in Latvia, Spain, Japan, the UK, Finland, Serbia, and the USA, covering topics such as labor law, NGO management, gender policies, science and innovation, international relations, and wartime business challenges.

The institution publishes the following scientific journals: "Works of ZIEIT" and "Digital Economy and IT".

The ZIEIT holds patents registered with the national patent office, including:

1. "Modern directions of information technology development in applied research" (state registration No. 0122U201321, valid 2022–2024).
2. Utility model patent No. 155371 for a method of manufacturing medium-caliber projectile casings from high-carbon steels (issued June 19, 2024).
3. Utility model patent No. 155371 for a method of manufacturing precision thin-walled capillary tubes from weldable steels and alloys (issued February 21, 2024).

Evaluation

The Institute has implemented an Education Quality Management System aimed at enhancing the educational process, scientific support, and interactive learning, ensuring graduates are professional, mobile, and competitive. The system includes organizational structures, procedures, and resources to manage and continuously improve the quality of education and programs. Self-assessment covers program design, admissions, teaching, outcomes, staff support, resources, and information transparency. Results are submitted to the National Agency for Quality Assurance of Higher Education during accreditation. Student satisfaction is regularly monitored through surveys, with results published online.
